



### QUICK FACTS

The Zero Tolerance Program has grown significantly. In March of 2018, a new program was implemented called SCRAM, which means we now offer portable PBT machines to our clients to rent. We average 30 continuous rentals per month on this program. With this many rentals it yields a profit of \$2,025.00 per month, averaging \$24,300.00 annually for SCRAM. The 2019 income projection for SCRAM is trending between \$8,000-\$9,000 monthly. Our total Zero Tolerance Program income for 2018 was \$20,083.14 above 2017's income. As of June 2019, our total Zero Tolerance Program income is already 32% above 2018. With the expansion of the program and the growing numbers, we have the potential to bring in even more profit. In order to maximize this growth, the County may want to consider making the coordinator a full time position.






