



QUICK FACTS

The Zero Tolerance Program has seen a decrease in the testing numbers for urinalysis. We have noticed a shift in testing requirements set by the court, from initial testing requirements of once a week to one to two times a month. This has affected our revenue by approximately \$10,000. We have also seen a decrease in PBTs, but that is largely due to the SCRAM units available. The SCRAM program was very successful in 2019, surpassing all goals I set for the year. I anticipate 2020's income to surpass 2019, even with the COVID-19 epidemic. In the first two months of 2020, we were already at a \$13,968.90 increased from that same time in 2019.






