### Community Outreach/Education

- 800+ phone and in-person office contacts
  - HHW
  - Natural resource questions: Burn permits, wildlife issues, water quality questions, invasive species concerns, firewood permits
- Tree sales
  - \$17,000 revenue (\$2,000 profit)
  - 30,000 trees and shrubs sold
  - Sold to over 75 residents for conservation purposes
- Petoskey Stone Festival
  - 5k Fun Run and educational booth
- Paddle Antrim
  - Director and member of grant committee
  - Public outreach/educational booth
- Aquatic Invasive Species workshop with TOMWC
  - 55 members of the public in attendance
