The year 2015 was a good year at Antrim County Airport.

Safety

The safety of our pilots, customers, staff and community is very important to us. We had another year without accident or injury.



Airport Fees

We have increased revenue from Airport fees. This continues our commitment to shift the base of operating income toward the users of the facility.



Fuel Sales

Fuel sales in aggregate for 2015 were at an all-time high. In particular, demand for Jet-A fuel (for: jet aircraft, turbine engine propeller craft or helicopter) has outpaced demand for fuel for piston engine craft. We believe that this indicates a continued increase in importance of customers who live outside of our county who also have significant personal disposable income streams.

Used Equipment Sales

We partnered with govdeals.com to facilitate the sale of our used equipment. This arraignment allowed for us to reach a wider audience of prospective buyers at a price point that more accurately reflects open market pricing.





Upgrade of Airfield lighting

We had a significant upgrade to your field signage and ramp lighting. Our new signs are sturdier and much more electrically efficient due to the LED technology of the lamps used. Our ramp lighting project was able to re-use the existing poles but now have integrated highly efficient LED lamps.


