

Antrim County CIP
Follow-up from 7/9/20

At the prior meeting, it was requested that I find information about two questions:

1. Can the CARES Act funds appropriated to the county in place of the August revenue sharing payment be used toward the trailer and/or the radios?

From reading the press release Pete had sent from MAC on June 30, I was under the understanding that this agreement was finalized. However, during my email inquiry with Deena Bosworth from MAC asking for additional information on the agreement, she stated that the legislation has not been enacted yet.

During the webinar, she did note that this is CARES Act money, and, as such, is not for offsetting reductions in revenues. The funds need to be spent in accordance with the Act. She said that she believed there would be a broad range of eligible expenditures, but she could not give definitive answers at that time.

For now, I would recommend these projects, if approved, be included in the 2021 budget recommendation with a note that these may be available to be pulled into 2020 to cover CARES Act funding.

2. Can the 800 MHz radios be paid for through the 911 fund, and where were the replaced radios purchased?

The ballot language for the 911 millage is attached. The purpose of the millage is for the operations of the 911 telephone and central dispatch system. This language is open to interpretation. However, the MCT project was charged to 911, and the Motorola radios were purchased in 2008 for \$102,187 from account 262000-348-980.000 E-911 Wireless Equipment.

Thank you for reaching out to me. I will answer those questions on the webinar today. What I heard from Treasury – and I asked multiple times, was that all payroll for public safety is eligible. I think they are being indirect about it because it may be a stretch, but they are using it for all MSP and MDOC payroll, so they must believe it's ok.

⊗ As for the FY 20 budget and the revenue sharing – it's not enacted yet so I don't have all the answers but I will cover what I do know.

**CONTINUED FUNDING 9-1-1 EMERGENCY TELEPHONE
AND CENTRAL DISPATCH**

This proposal is a renewal of the previously approved millage and will permit the County to levy up to 1/2 of one mill (\$0.50 cents per \$1,000.00 of taxable valuation) to provide funds for the continued operations of the comprehensive countywide 9-1-1 Emergency Telephone and Central Dispatch System.

Shall the tax limitation imposed under Article IX, Section 6 of the Michigan Constitution on the amount of ad valorem taxes which may be imposed by the County of Antrim, State of Michigan, against taxable property in the County be increased by one-half (1/2) of one mill (\$0.50 cents per \$1,000 of taxable value) on the taxable value of such property for a period of five (5) years, 2018 through 2022, inclusive, for the purpose of providing funds for the continued operations of the comprehensive countywide 9-1-1 Emergency Telephone and Central Dispatch System, and shall the County be authorized to levy such millage for these purposes? If approved and levied in its entirety, this millage would raise an estimated \$876,239 for Antrim County in 2018.

State budget deal uses federal aid to compensate for cuts to local governments

Counties and other local governments will not suffer deep cuts in state aid during this budget year, under an agreement announced between Gov. Gretchen Whitmer and legislative leaders Monday evening.

The deal includes withholding \$97 million from the FY20 August revenue sharing payment for local governments — [\\$53 million of which was slated for counties](#). However, \$150 million from the federal Coronavirus Relief Fund will be allocated to local governments for any COVID-19 related expenses. This is approximately 1.5 times the amount allocated for the August revenue sharing payment.

The \$150 million will be divided up based on the current percentage of revenue sharing payment and not on a first come, first served basis. This appropriation is above and beyond the \$200 million from the fund for April and May public safety and public health expenses and the additional \$100 million for hazard pay that is appropriated by [Senate Bill 690](#).



MAC anticipates more guidance from the Department of Treasury on how to access these funds in early July. An announcement of another webinar is expected later this week.

Combined with other outlays to K-12 schools, colleges and universities and public safety and Medicaid spending, the agreement would commit \$3 billion of the \$3.1 billion the state received via the federal CARES Act this spring.

“Obviously, we are pleased to see state leaders recognize the need to protect critical front-line services that counties provide,” said Stephan Currie, MAC executive director. “It might not be Christmas in July, but it’s most welcome news. Of course, now the work turns to the upcoming state budget year that starts Oct. 1, where another multi-billion-dollar deficit is looming.”
