PROPOSAL FOR TRASH MILLAGE

This proposal will permit the Township to levy up to 1.9 mills for the purpose of providing funds for weekly curbside trash collection and bi-annual township trash collection and disposal. The electors previously approved 1.5 mills for these purposes that expired after the December, 2015 levy. Specifically, the proposal renews the current 1.5 mills that was last levied and seeks an additional .4 mills for these purposes.

Shall the limitation on the amount of ad valorem taxes which may be levied by the Township of Custer, Antrim County, Michigan, against taxable property in the Township be increased by up to 1.9 mills (\$1.90 per \$1,000 of taxable value) for a period of four (4) years, 2016 through 2019, inclusive, for the purpose of providing funds for weekly curbside trash collection and bi-annual township trash collection and disposal, and shall the Township levy such millage for these purposes? If approved and levied in its entirety, this millage would raise an estimated \$159,841 for the Township in 2016.
