

Information Required for Adult Adoption

Complete the Adoption Questionnaire and provide copies of the following to the court:

- Copy of Petitioner's Birth Certificate.
- Copy of Adoptee's Birth Certificate.
- Copy of Petitioner's Marriage License.
- Copy of Adoptee's Marriage License.
- If Adoptee's biological/legal parent is deceased, a copy of death certificate.
- Copies of all pages of divorce judgement of all previous marriages for both petitioners.
- If adoptee's name has been changed, a copy of the court order changing the name.
- A short written statement from adoptee giving reason for adoption.
- A written statement signed by the petitioner stating the reasons for adoption.
- Completed adult adoption questionnaire, signed by petitioners. Be sure to give complete information about the birth parent(s), since it is required that he or she receives notice of adoption.

The birth parent(s) will be sent a notice of the Petition of Adoption as required by Michigan Adoption Code.
