

ORDINANCE NO. 1-71

AN ORDINANCE TO PROVIDE FOR THE REGULATION AND OPERATION OF VESSELS AND TO PROMOTE THE SAFE. USE OF THE WATERS OF THE JORDAN RIVER IN THE COUNTY OF ANTRIM.

THE COUNTY OF ANTRIM, STATE OF MICHIGAN ORDAINS: JORDAN RIVER - MOTORBOATS PROHIBITED.

Section 1.

On the waters of the Jordan River, within Antrim County, State of Michigan, no person shall operate any vessel propelled by machinery.

Section 2. AUTHORITY:

This ordinance is enacted under the authority of Act 303, Public Acts of 1967, (M.S.A. 18.1287 (17) being identical to a State Administrative Rule duly promulgated and established by the Natural Resources Commission and filed in the office of the Secretary of State, January 4, 1971.

Section 3. PENALTY:

Violations of this ordinance shall be a misdemeanor and shall be punishable by a fine not to exceed one hundred dollars (\$100) together with the costs of prosecution or imprisonment in the county jail or such other place of detention as the court may prescribe, for a period not to exceed ninety (90) days, or said fine, costs of prosecution, and imprisonment, at the discretion of the court.

This ordinance shall become effective sixty (60) days after its passage.
