Ouvry that the Antrim County Board of Commissioners adopt the following Ordinance:

"ORDINANCE NUMBER ONE OF 1978

WHEREAS, vehicles have been left in the parking lots of the Antrim County government facility for extended periods of time while the occupants thereof have had no business dealings in the governmental facility, and

WHEREAS, such vehicles have deprived the public who have bona fide reasons to visit the governmental facility and workers at the governmental facility of parking spaces, and

WHEREAS, such vehicles also make snow removal more difficult;

NOW, THEREFORE, THE ANTRIM COUNTY BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS ORDAINS:

SECTION 1: It shall be unlawful to park any vehicle in any County parking lot on County land described as the Courthouse Square and Lots 3, 4, 5, 6 and 7 of Block F of the original plat of the Village of Bellaire and Court Street as vacated, which is bounded by Grove Street on the East, M-88 (Cayuga Street) on the South, Block F alley on the West and Broad Street on the North in the Village of Bellaire, Kearney Township, contrary to the provisions of this ordinance.

SECTION 2: No vehicle shall be parked in any parking lot as described in SECTION 1 unless an occupant of the vehicle is conducting business within the Antrim County governmental facility, which is known as the 'Antrim County Building.'

SECTION 3: No vehicle shall be parked in any of the County parking lots described in SECTION 1 unless the vehicle is parked within a parking space as designated by parallel yellow lines on the parking lot surface.

SECTION 4: No vehicle shall be parked in any parking space in any of the County parking lots described in SECTION 1 which is marked 'RESERVED.'

SECTION 5: The term 'vehicle' means every device in, upon or by which any person or property is or may be transported or drawn upon a highway.


SECTION 6: Any person who shall be convicted of a violation of this ordinance shall be subject to a fine not to exceed One hundred (\$100.00) dollars."
