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# ANIMAL CONTROL

## ANIMAL CONTROL

### In Summary

These charts below represent the last five years at the Antrim County Animal Shelter. In 2009 the shelter took in 939 animals and euthanized 324. In 2014 the shelter still showed a decline in the intake at 640, although higher than the previous year 621. In 2014 the shelter showed even a lower rate of 166 euthanized.

During these last five (5) years the shelter has continued to operate as an open intake facility, turning no Antrim County resident away when they need to bring their unwanted pet or stray animal in. We also do not charge a drop off fee to surrender an unwanted animal, which has helped with people being more honest and less likely to turn animals loose.

Animals must be held in the facility for five (5) to seven (7)

business days taking up valuable kennel space. Employees have spent a lot of time advertising the adoptable and stray animals on several web sites, including Facebook, Pet Finder, and Craigslist and have seen great success.

There is a lot of time spent grooming, bathing, and training animals in our facility.

The employees work closely with local veterinarians and local rescue groups. One donor donates money to two local veterinarians for spay and neutering, and other medical needs for homeless animals.

One veterinarian also has been donating nearly all altered animal procedures at only the cost of materials, the time is donated. We are also involved with two (2) Rescue groups that

will take animals from the shelter and assist in adopting the animals to good homes. These groups also help with animals that are facing long recoveries due to medical issues.

By having an officer in the shelter and one on the road we are able to solve a lot of problems with animals running loose, barking, etc., and educating the public. It is believed that this has helped reduce the number of complaints in the last five (5) years.

In summary it has been another successful year in the Antrim County Animal Shelter. The shelter and its employees are striving to meet the growing needs of the citizens and animals we serve.



## GUN REGISTRATION / CPL

New CPL's (Concealed Pistol License) issued during 2014 totaled 108, while 210 were renewal, compared to 227 New CPL in 2013, and 174 renewals. Seven (7) CPL were suspended, and three (3) were revoked, seven (7) were refused, one (1) reinstated, and eleven (11) were exempt (Law Enforcement).

Purchase permits (without CPL) totaled 409 in 2014 compared to 533 in 2013, while 314 Pistol Sales Records (With CPL) were recorded in 2014, a decrease from 517 in 2013.





Officer training totaled 303.25 hours involving twenty-one (21) officers.


A total of thirteen (13) livery inspections were conducted with 88 boats inspected.




## Remembering "Kellie"
