

ANTRIM COUNTY
ORDINANCE NUMBER ONE OF 1984

WHEREAS the waters flowing under and adjacent to the Torch River Bridge and Clam River Bridge are frequently used by boat traffic and it appearing that public safety can be jeopardized by persons fishing or throwing or dropping items from the Torch River Bridge and Clam River Bridge and by persons diving from these bridges and whereas the Torch River Bridge and Clam River Bridge are part of the county road system under jurisdiction of the Antrim County Road Commission,

Therefore, the County of Antrim ordains:

Section 1: Definitions

The term "Torch River Bridge", as used in this ordinance means, the bridge which spans Torch River and is adjacent to Milton Township, Antrim County, and includes the abutments and sloped walls at each end of the bridge.

The term "Clam River Bridge", as used in this ordinance means, the bridge which spans Clam River between Helena Township and Forest Home Township, Antrim County and includes the abutments and sloped walls at each end of the bridge.

Section 2: Action Prohibited

It shall be unlawful for any person to:

1. Fish from the Torch River Bridge or Clam River Bridge,
2. Jump or dive from the Torch River Bridge or Clam River Bridge,

3. Throw or drop any item from the Torch River Bridge or Clam River Bridge.

Section 3: Penalty

Any person convicted of violating this ordinance shall be subject to a penalty which shall not exceed a fine of \$100.00, or imprisonment for 90 days, or both.

Section 4: Effective Date

This ordinance will take effect in 90 days from the date hereof.
