

*This proposal will permit the Township Ambulance Authority to levy up to 1 mill for the purpose of providing funds for acquiring, construction, improvement, repair, and maintenance of ambulance buildings and facilities, and for equipping, operating, and maintaining an ambulance service within the territorial limits of the Township Ambulance Authority in the years 2021-2022, inclusive.*

“Shall the limitation on the amount of taxes which may be imposed on taxable property within the territorial limits of the Township Ambulance Authority (Central Lake Township, Chestonia Township, Custer Township, Forest Home Township, Helena Township, Kearney Township, Mancelona Township, Star Township, and Warner Township), County of Antrim, State of Michigan, be increased by up to \$1.00 per thousand dollars (\$1,000) (1 mill) of the taxable value on all taxable property within the territorial limits of the Township Ambulance Authority for two (2) years, being 2021 through 2022, inclusive, for the purpose of providing funds for acquiring, construction, improvement, repair, and maintenance of ambulance buildings and facilities, and for equipping, operating, and maintaining an ambulance service within the territorial limits of the Township Ambulance Authority, and shall the Township Ambulance Authority Board be authorized to levy such millage for these purposes? If approved and levied in its entirety, it is estimated that the 1 mill would raise an estimated \$918,998. within the territorial limits of the Township Ambulance Authority for the Township Ambulance Authority when first levied in 2021.”

**CHEBOYGAN-OTSEGO-PRESQUE ISLE EDUCATIONAL SERVICE DISTRICT  
SPECIAL EDUCATION MILLAGE RENEWAL PROPOSAL**

**This proposal will allow the intermediate school district to continue to levy special education millage previously approved by the electors.**

**Shall the limitation on the amount of taxes which may be assessed against all property in Cheboygan-Otsego-Presque Isle Educational Service District, Michigan, be increased by 0.6418 mill (\$0.6418 on each \$1,000 of taxable valuation) for a period of 6 years, 2021 to 2026, inclusive, to provide funds for the education of students with a disability; the estimate of the revenue the intermediate school district will collect if the millage is approved and levied in 2021 is approximately \$2,300,000 from local property taxes authorized herein (this is a renewal of millage that expired with the 2020 tax levy)?**

**GAYLORD COMMUNITY SCHOOLS  
SINKING FUND MILLAGE PROPOSAL**

**Shall the limitation on the amount of taxes which may be assessed against all property in Gaylord Community Schools, Otsego, Antrim and Crawford Counties, Michigan, be increased by and the board of education be authorized to levy not to exceed 1.6 mills (\$1.60 on each \$1,000 of taxable valuation) for a period of 5 years, 2021 to 2025, inclusive, to create a sinking fund for the purchase of real estate for sites for, and the construction or repair of, school buildings, for school security improvements, for the acquisition or upgrading of technology and all other purposes authorized by law; the estimate of the revenue the school district will collect if the millage is approved and levied in 2021 is approximately \$1,727,800?**
